### **Milton Abbas Community Lunch Club**

Milton Abbas Community Lunch Club is a sub-group of MATCH which is a registered charity

One objective of MATCH is

- “To promote and provide support for the inhabitants of the Parish of Milton Abbas by uniting the inhabitants and other organisations with the object of improving villagers’ lives”.
- **Objectives/Aims of lunch club**
- to provide nutritional meals to people over the age of 55 years who live in the vicinity of Milton Abbas
- to provide convivial surroundings
- to provide a meal on a monthly basis

#### **Activity**

- The lunch club carries out a service wholly through voluntary effort and contributions.
- A main meal and pudding will be made available for a modest cost.
- Free transport provided if required.
- The lead for the group will ensure volunteer cooks are available for the stated session.
- The lunch club will register with Dorset Council and participate in the Food Standards Agency food rating scheme.
- Volunteers will undertake Level 2 food hygiene training as set out by the Food Standards Agency.
- Paperwork will be kept as required for the auditors.
- If the club should fold any funds and/or equipment will become the property of MATCH.

#### **Management Committee**

- A management committee will meet twice a year to discuss costs and menus.
- The management committee has the right to ask anyone to leave the meal if they are causing a disturbance.

#### **Membership**

- There are no members of the lunch club a person will put their name down at Milton Abbas post office if they wish to attend.
- The right to attend is open to anyone over the age of 55 years who lives in the vicinity of Milton Abbas

#### **Finance**

- Cooks will be re-imbursed for ingredients bought on production of a receipt
- Any money raised during the year will be used to support the Christmas meal.
- If sufficient funds are not available MATCH will assist with donations of fund
